

## Uniform/ Behaviour expectations

Dear Parent/Carer

Here at Hyde we have high standards and we hope that you give us your support in this matter. We expect all students to wear full uniform and carry correct equipment for all their lessons and behave appropriately at all times. Below you will find a list to help you when choosing new items of uniform. Students themselves do not always make clear to parents what they are allowed and what is not correct for school.

Trousers must be plain black, tailored ones with no studs, patterns, stripes etc and certainly not jeans

Skirts must be plain, black and of appropriate length

Socks must be plain black or white

School polo shirt with nothing worn underneath that shows (top button must be fastened if a t-shirt is worn underneath)

School sweatshirt

Shoes - not trainers or boots, must be black and plain, suitable for all weathers (see poster). By the beginning of the new term in January we would expect all students to have the appropriate footwear as this is NOT a new rule

Outer clothing must be removed in lessons

In year 10 and 11 girls are allowed a DISCRETE amount of make-up which is foundation and mascara ONLY. Any girl with more than this will be asked to remove it. Girls year 9 and below are not allowed ANY make-up.

Hair should not be less than no 2 and have no patterns/lines or shaved areas (boys) and girls should not have extensions or fashion items. Simple slides/headbands that are there for a reason and not as a fashion accessory are acceptable. Asian girls should have a PLAIN headscarf where desired, with no extras. Again simple items to keep it in place are acceptable.

Students should have at least a pen, pencil and ruler in every lesson (a pencil case with several items would be even better)

A bag to carry books home in order to do homework is a necessity.
