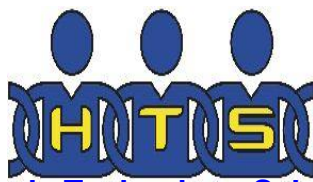
This policy supports the school policy for PHSE and citizenship
